Family and child supervision policy

Dear Guests,

At Gleneagle, we provide a safe and fun environment for families to holiday together with lots to do and experience as a family. We are delighted that you have chosen to stay with us.

Apart from families, we have many other guests and visitors in the hotel, and with that in mind, we would ask everyone to respect the other people around them, including other customers, staff and management of the hotel.

We understand that children will be children so we ask that parents adhere to the following house rules.

- All children must be closely supervised by a parent or suitable caregiver while in the public areas of the hotel, to include corridors, bars, restaurants, lobbies and reception areas of the hotel.

Maintenance

Should any maintenance issues arise during your stay with us, please contact the hotel reception on '0'.

Power

On arriving to the apartment you will notice a white unit on the wall just inside the main door of your apartment. Leave one of your key cards in the slot and the power will stay on. Remove it when you leave the apartment and the power will switch off after two minutes.

Underfloor Heating HOW TO USE:

There are a small number of white switches situated low down in each room. All of these switches must be in the 'on' position for the heating to work. Once they are on, set the temperature on the dial inside the door of each room and slide the switch to the 'on' position. Heating should be left on at all times during your stay.

Water Heating HOW TO USE:

1. The unit located in the closet in the hall controls the water heating.
 2. Water timing is set by the hotel and is normally sufficient.
- Should you wish to alter, turn the small dial on the right to 15, 30, 60 or 120 minutes.
4. Then Press the same small dial once.
 5. Ensure the switch is in the 'on' position.

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Public Health Tobacco Acts 2002 And 2004

As of March 29th 2004, it is the policy of Gleneagle, in accordance with legislation, that all of its workplaces are smoke-free and that all employees have a right to work in a smoke-free environment. Covering smoke detectors will result in immediate eviction. Smoking is prohibited throughout the entire hotel including balconies. The prohibition applies to all employees, customers, visitors, consultants and contractors.

A person found guilty of an offence under Section 47 – Smoking Prohibition – is liable to a fine of up to €3000. Under this policy, Staff are obliged to refuse service to a customer who insists on smoking and may ultimately request a customer to vacate the premises. We appreciate your assistance in the implementation of the workplace smoking ban.

1) We will apply a minimum charge of €250 and a warning to guests found smoking in bedrooms.

2) Further warnings may lead to increased fines and/or eviction.

Intoxicating Liquor Act 2003

We draw your attention to the following recent changes to the Intoxicating Liquor Act

Act

Persons under the age of 18 years are not permitted to be in the Hotel Bars i.e. The Green Room after 11.30pm, and the Backstage Bar after 10.00pm. All children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Closing times of bars are at the Duty Managers discretion.

Persons over the age of 18 and under the age of 21 are required to produce suitable proof of age, on request, in order to be served. Suitable Identification means: Passport, Drivers License or Garda ID Card issues by a member state of the E.U.

Only persons over the age of 18 are permitted to consume alcohol on the premises this includes in the bedrooms.

If you look under 25, you will need photo ID to buy a drink. It is an offence to buy alcohol for any person under 18.
