The Origins of Hotel67 @Gleneagle

Sometimes, the best things spring from an original foundation.

First built back in 1967, we stripped these old rooms back to their bare bones and unearthed a minimalist beauty – a blank canvas for creative thinking.

The sense of history and character was palpable. It was like opening a time capsule of vintage features and hidden craftsmanship. The architectural simplicity of the rooms – the original brickwork, exposed copper, structural features and high ceilings - inspired us to embrace their minimalistic beauty. And so, Hotel67 was born.

The name Hotel67 is our homage to 1967 – the greatest year in music history. The year these guestrooms were first built was the same year that The Doors, Pink Floyd and Jimi Hendrix all released debut albums. The same year that The Beatles released Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band.

Back home in Ireland, Van Morrison exploded onto the airwaves with Brown Eyed Girl, Joe Dolan's The House with the Whitewashed Gable dominated the charts and The Dubliners Seven Drunken Nights had the nation singing-a-long. Music had never sounded so good.


The Flesk Restaurant

Emergency

Dial Reception in the event of an emergency (Dial '0').

Emergency Fire Procedures

A detailed floor plan is located on the back of your bedroom door. If you discover a fire, please alert a member of our staff and follow their instructions.

Action in case of fire:

- 1. Continuous sounding of the alarm bell means an emergency.
- 2. Do not run. Walk quietly to the nearest exit to which you are directed.
- 3. Do not use elevators.
- 4. Once outside the building go to the nearest Assembly Point. Do not re-enter under any circumstances.
- 5. Keep clear of the main entrance and any emergency services on site.

If you have to stay in your room:


- 1. Touch the door, if hot, do not open.
- 2. Wet sheets and stuff them completely around the door.
- 3. Block any vents that are emitting smoke.
- 4. Stay low if there is smoke in the room. Keep a wet cloth over your nose and mouth as a filter.
- 5. If the door and walls are hot, bail water on them with a container.
- 6. Call the operator, give your number and explain that you cannot leave your room.


Illness

Doctor





Public Health Tobacco Acts 2002 And 2004

As of March 29th 2004, it is the policy of The Gleneagle Hotel, in accordance with legislation, that all of its workplaces are smoke-free and that all employees have a right to work in a smoke-free environment.

Covering smoke detectors will result in immediate eviction.

Smoking is prohibited throughout the entire hotel including balconies.

The prohibition applies to all employees, customers, visitors,


consultants and contractors.

A person found guilty of an offence under Section 47 – Smoking Prohibition – is liable to a fine of up to €3000.

Under this policy, Staff are obliged to refuse service to a customer who insists on smoking and may ultimately request a customer to vacate the premises.

We appreciate your assistance in the implementation of the workplace smoking ban.

- 1) We will apply a minimum charge of €100.00 and a warning to guests found smoking in bedrooms.
 - 2) Further warnings may lead to increased fines and/or eviction.



Intoxicating Liquor Act 2003

We draw your attention to the following recent changes to the Intoxicating Liquor Act.

Act

Persons under the age of 18 years are not permitted to be in the Hotel Bars i.e. The Green Room after 11.30pm, and the Backstage Bar after 10.00pm. All children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Closing times of bars are at the Duty Managers discretion.

Persons over the age of 18 and under the age of 21 are required to produce suitable proof of age, on request, in order to be served.

Suitable Identification means: Passport, Drivers License or Garda ID Card issues by a member state of the E.U.

Only persons over the age of 18 are permitted to consume alcohol on the premises this includes in the bedrooms.

If you look under 25, you will need photo ID to buy a drink. It is an offence to buy alcohol for any person under 18.

- Steam Room and Sauna Strictly over 18's
- Cardiovascular & Weights Gym (Over16's only)

Lake Cruises
